Preambles and Object of the Contract

WHEREAS, UNHCR wishes to retain the Contractor to provide professional photo services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract;

WHEREAS, the Contractor represents that it is qualified, ready, able and willing, and possesses the necessary expertise, qualified personnel, facilities, equipment, tools, insurance and other mean, to provide these services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and subject to the terms and conditions contained herein, UNHCR and the Contractor (collectively referred to as “the Parties”) agree as follows:

Article 1 – Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this agreement is for the purchase on a “non-exclusive basis” of professional photo services as described in the terms of references document provided within the Annex B (the “Services”) in accordance with the terms and conditions specified herein to UNHCR based on firm prices agreed among the Parties as specified in Annex D hereto, which the Contractor agrees not to increase for the duration specified herein.

Article 2 – Contract Documents

2.1 This document, together with the other named documents annexed hereto and referred to below, constitute the entire Contract (the “Contract”) between UNHCR and the Contractor:

Article 10. Miscellaneous

10.1. If any provision of this Contract shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable (in whole or in part), the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

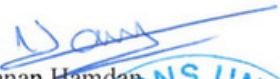

- (d) Annex B: Terms of Reference (“TOR”)
- (e) Annex C (UNHCR tender document RFQ/TUN/2021/004); and
- (f) Annex D (Contractor’s bidding document Contractor’s offer dated 13/10/2021).

2.3 This Contract embodies the entire agreement of the Parties with regard to the subject-matter hereof and supersedes all prior representations, agreements, contracts and proposals, whether written or oral, by and between the Parties on this subject. No promises, understandings, obligations or agreements, oral or written, relating to the subject-matter hereof exist between the Parties except as herein expressly set forth.

2.4 Any document or receipt issued in connection with this Contract shall be consistent with and subject to the terms and conditions of this Contract, and in case of any inconsistency the terms and conditions of this Contract shall prevail.

Article 3 – Contract Term

3.1 This Contract shall take effect on 21 March 2022 (the “Effective Date”).

3.2 This Contract shall remain in effect until 20 March 2024, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of this Contract.

3.3 UNHCR may, at its sole option, extend the term of this Contract, under the same terms and conditions as set forth in this Contract, for a maximum of one (1) additional period of up to 1 year, provided that UNHCR provides written notice of its intention to do so at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the current term of the Contract.

Article 4 – Scope of Contractor’s obligations

4.1 Upon request from UNHCR by way of issuance of a purchase order issued separately and pursuant to this Contract, the Contractor will perform and carry out professional photography services as set out in the TOR attached as Annex B (the “Services”)

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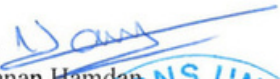
